On May 18, 2016, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board (“Board”) issued a Final Decision and Order (“Order”) limiting Respondent’s medicine and surgery license. Respondent was required to complete two to four (2-4) hours of education in “medical record keeping”, complete five (5) hours of education in “safe and appropriate prescribing of opioids” and complete three to five (3-5) hours of education in “ethics” pursuant to the terms of the Order.

Respondent has submitted proof that he successfully completed the required education and as a result the following is entered:


ORDER
