On June 24, 2016, the Cosmetology Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter by which the Board ordered that pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 440.22, the costs of this proceeding be assessed against the Respondents. The Board received the Affidavits of costs from the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and the Division of Hearings and Appeals. The Board considered the Affidavits of Costs on August 25, 2016, and orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 440.22, the costs of this proceeding in the amount of \$2,228.20 are hereby assessed against the Respondents, and shall be payable by the Respondents to the Department of Safety and Professional Services. **Failure of the Respondents to make payment on or before August 25, 2017, shall constitute a violation of the Order unless the Respondents petition for and the Board grants a different deadline.** Under Wis. Stats. § 440.22(3), the Department of Safety and Professional Services may not restore, renew or otherwise issue any credential to the Respondents until the Respondents have made payment to the Department in the full amount assessed.
