### Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services Access to the Public Records of the Reports of Decisions

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#### Please read this agreement prior to viewing the Decision:

- The Reports of Decisions is designed to contain copies of all orders issued by credentialing authorities within the Department of Safety and Professional Services from November, 1998 to the present. In addition, many but not all orders for the time period between 1977 and November, 1998 are posted. Not all orders issued by a credentialing authority constitute a formal disciplinary action.
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- There may be discrepancies between the online copies and the original document. Original documents should be consulted as the definitive representation of the order's content. Copies of original orders may be obtained by mailing requests to the Department of Safety and Professional Services, PO Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708-8935. The Department charges copying fees. *All requests must cite the case number, the date of the order, and respondent's name* as it appears on the order.

You are hereby notified that your Dwelling Contractor credential is suspended for one year, effective June 1, 2016.

After the one year suspension, you may request to have your credential reinstated. This request shall be in writing. The reinstatement process is set forth in Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.10(1)(f).


You have the right to request a hearing on the suspension by sending a request for hearing to the Department, addressed to Department of Safety and Professional Services, Chief Legal Counsel, P.O. Box 8368, Madison, Wisconsin 53708-8368, which must be received by the Department no later than 30 days from the date of mailing of this Notice. The date of mailing of this Notice is May 2, 2016. Any hearing on the suspension will be held in accordance with the requirements set forth in Wis. Stat. ch. 227.

The basis for the suspension is your conduct during your contract to work on the dwelling at 4511 S. 6<sup>th</sup> Street, Milwaukee, WI 53204. You were hired to work on an alteration to a one or two family dwelling, with construction scheduled to start April 15, 2015, with a completion date of June 1, 2015. City of Milwaukee records show you did not pull a permit for this work, as required by the city of Milwaukee ordinance. This conduct is subject to discipline under Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.10(1)(a)5.& 8. for violating local ordinances.

Furthermore, you were in receipt of five payments between April 20 and May 23, 2015, totaling \$10,692.00 dollars for the contracted work. The majority of the contracted work was not completed. On August 31, 2015, Complainant filed a small claims action, Milwaukee County Case No. 15-SC-023372, against you. The case was decided in favor of the Complainant and a default judgement of \$10,250.00 was awarded against you. This amount is only \$442.00 less

than the amount you were paid. This conduct evidences a lack of trustworthiness and is subject to discipline as misconduct under Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.10(1)(a)5.
