You are hereby notified that your Dwelling Contractor credential is suspended for one week, beginning September 8, 2016.

The basis for this suspension is the contract you signed on September 28, 2015. You were hired, by the Complainant, to add a two story deck to Complainant's dwelling. At that time, you were paid \$3,000.00 by Complainant as a down payment. You pulled a permit for the job on October 14, 2015. Since that date, you performed no work at the site and have demonstrated no intention to finish performance on the contract. In addition, you have not returned the down payment to the Complainant.

The above conduct constitutes misconduct under Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.10(1)(a)5. Misconduct includes financial misconduct under Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.003(43). This violation is a basis for discipline pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code ch. SPS 305.

After the one week suspension, you may request, in writing, to have your credential reinstated. The reinstatement process is set forth in Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.10(1)(f). Upon reinstatement, the Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) will impose the following conditions upon the reinstated credential. You will have one month from the date of the reissued license to deliver to the Department proof that you have returned the \$3,000.00 down payment to Ashleigh Meinholz. If the Department does not receive proof that the down payment has been returned within this one month period, your Dwelling Contractor credential will be suspended until the down payment has been returned.

You have the right to request a hearing on the suspension by sending a request for hearing to the Department of Safety and Professional Services, Chief Legal Counsel, P.O. Box 8368, Madison, Wisconsin 53707-8368, which must be received by the Department no later than 30 days from the date of mailing of this Notice. The date of mailing of this Notice is August 8,

2016. Any hearing on the suspension will be held in accordance with the requirements set forth in Wis. Stat. ch. 227.


