On August 17, 2016, the Social Work Section of the Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling, and Social Work Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter by which the Section ordered that pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 440.22, that eighty percent of the costs of this proceeding be assessed against Respondent. The Section received the Affidavits of costs from the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and Division of Hearings and Appeals. The Section considered the Affidavits of Costs on October 25, 2016, and orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 440.22, that eighty percent of the costs of this proceeding in the amount of \$6,645.15 are hereby assessed against the Respondent, and shall be payable by the Respondent to the Department of Safety and Professional Services.

Failure of Respondent to make payment on or before October 25, 2017, shall constitute a violation of the Order unless the Respondent petitions for and the Section grants a different deadline. Under Wis. Stats. § 440.22(3), the Department of Safety and Professional Services may not restore, renew or otherwise issue any credential to the Respondent until the Respondent has made payment to the Department in the full amount assessed.

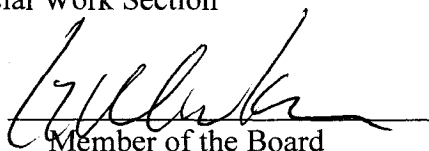
