#### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On or about November 11, 2015, the Wisconsin Real Estate Appraisers Board (Board) issued a Final Decision and Order #4346 (Order) suspending Respondent's Certified Residential Appraiser credential (#371-9) for thirty (30) days, requiring the completion of continuing education, prohibiting Respondent from serving as a supervisory appraiser, and requiring a review of a log of appraisal reports as specified in the Order.
- 2. On or about June 29, 2016, Respondent informed the Board that he retired from the appraisal business and wished to surrender his license.
- 3. As of the date of this order, a check of the Department of Safety and Professional Services records show that Respondent does not have any complaints or other disciplinary actions pending. See Wis. Stat. § 440.19.

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. The Wisconsin Real Estate Appraisers Board has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 440.19 and 458.26, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
- 2. The SURRENDER of credential number 371-9 issued to WILLARD PARR to practice as a Certified Residential Appraiser is ACCEPTED.
- 3. In the event Respondent petitions the Board for reinstatement or licensure as any level of Appraiser, the Board may enter an order denying such petition without further notice or hearing. Whether to grant a license and whether to impose any limitations or restrictions on any license shall be in the discretion of the Board.
- 4. Respondent shall immediately return all indicia of Wisconsin Appraisal certification or licensure to the Department Monitor at the address below:
