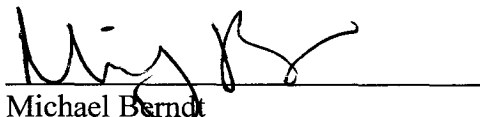

You are hereby notified that you are subject to an administrative forfeiture of \$1,000.00 in accordance with Wisconsin Admin. Code § SPS 305.125(1)(b)1. This forfeiture shall be paid within 30 days of the date of mailing of this Notice, or a 12% interest penalty will be assessed.

You have the right to request a review of the assessment of forfeiture by sending a request to the Administrator, Division of Industry Services, P.O. Box 2658, Madison, Wisconsin 53701-2658, which must be received by the Administrator no later than 30 days from the date of mailing of this Notice. The date of mailing of this Notice is November 14, 2016. Any review of the assessment of forfeiture will be held in accordance with the requirements set forth in Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.125(6-8).

The basis for this administrative forfeiture is the work you performed at 3601 West Burnham Street, Milwaukee, Wis. 53215. While working at this site, you installed plumbing, while not licensed to install plumbing. You have admitted to this conduct, which is in violation of Wis. Stat. § 145.06(1)(a) and Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.90(1)(a). The administrative forfeiture of \$1000.00 was assessed following the guidelines established in Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.125(1)(b)1.
