On April 19, 2007, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On September 14, 2017, the Board considered Respondent's request for return to full licensure, or in the alternative, reduction in drug and alcohol screens and termination of AA/NA meetings. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to not less than fourteen (14) screens per year and one (1) annual hair test.
2. Respondent's request for full, unrestricted licensure or termination of the AA/NA requirement is hereby DENIED. In the alternative, the Board reduces the frequency of AA/NA meetings to one (1) per week. Respondent needs to practice nursing under the conditions of the modified Board Order (04/19/2007) before the Board will consider amending other requirements.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
