On October 4, 2007, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("October 4, 2007 Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license (#115740-30) for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On May 11, 2017, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby DENIED. Respondent must practice nursing under the current conditions of the October 4, 2007 Order before the Board will consider amending other requirements.
