
On September 23, 2009, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's pharmacist license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On January 17, 2017, the Board considered Respondent's request for removal of the limitations and the return of her license to full, unrestricted status. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for the return of her pharmacist license (#14955-40) to full, unrestricted status is hereby GRANTED.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credential are hereby removed.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
