On January 28, 2010, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On March 9, 2017, the Board considered Respondent's request for full licensure or, in the alternative, a reduction in drug and alcohol screens and a reduction in AA/NA meetings. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is GRANTED. The frequency of Respondent's drug and alcohol screens is hereby reduced to 36 per year and one annual hair test.
2. Respondent's requests for full licensure and a reduction in AA/NA meetings are DENIED due to insufficient time under the Order to demonstrate adequate compliance.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
