On May 6, 2010, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. A stay of suspension was granted and Respondent's license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On June 8, 2017, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol testing, termination of treatment, and termination of AA/NA meetings attendance reporting requirements. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol testing is hereby GRANTED. The frequency of drug and alcohol testing is reduced to not less than thirty-six (36) screens per year.
2. Respondent's request for termination of treatment is hereby GRANTED.
3. Respondent's request for termination of AA/NA meeting attendance reporting requirements is hereby DENIED. Respondent needs to practice nursing under the conditions of the modified Board Order before the Board will consider amending additional requirements.
4. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
5. This order is effective the date of its signing.
