On March 24, 2011, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On April 13, 2017, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens and termination of the AA/NA requirement. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is hereby reduced to not less than 14 urine screens per year and one annual hair test while she not working as a nurse. Upon employment as a nurse, Respondent's frequency shall increase to not less than 36 urine screens per year.

2. The Board hereby DENIES Respondent's request for termination of the AA/NA requirement due to insufficient time under the Order, but GRANTS a reduction in the frequency of meetings to one per month.

3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.

4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
