On November 10, 2011, the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services issued an Order Granting Limited License ("Order") to Applicant for a private security person permit. Among other terms, the Order requires that Applicant successfully complete an anger management program and arrange for his security guard supervisor(s) to submit quarterly work reports. On April 11, 2017, Applicant's private security person permit was suspended for failure to comply with the above requirements.

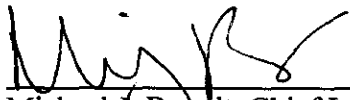
Based upon the information of record, which includes proof that Applicant has now completed an anger management program:
