On August 16, 2012, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions. Respondent may petition the Board for modification or removal of the limitations after working as a nurse, at least half-time, for two years.

On February 9, 2017, the Board considered Respondent's request for removal of the limitations and the return of her license to full, unrestricted status. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for the return of her professional nursing license (#161594-30) to full, unrestricted status is hereby DENIED for failure to demonstrate continuous and successful compliance (i.e. errors in documentation). Respondent must fully comply with the complete terms and conditions of the Order for at least one (1) full year.
