On August 14, 2013, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On February 8, 2017, the Board designee considered Respondent's request to terminate the drug and alcohol treatment required pursuant to the Order. Based upon the information of record, including a recommendation from Respondent's Treater, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request to eliminate the therapy requirement is GRANTED.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
