On June 13, 2013, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On October 12, 2017, the Board considered Respondent's request for termination of home health as a practice limitation and a reduction in AA/NA meetings. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for termination of home health as a practice limitation and a reduction in AA/NA meetings is DENIED for failure to demonstrate continuous and successful compliance under the terms of the Order (06/16/2013).
