On December 8, 2016, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (Board) issued a Final Decision and Order (Dec. 8<sup>th</sup>, 2016 Order) suspending Respondent's professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions including, but not limited to, completion of an assessment by an approved mental health provider experienced in evaluating health care practitioners' fitness to practice. The Dec. 8<sup>th</sup>, 2016 Order further states that Respondent's license shall be limited in a manner to address any concerns the Board has with the conduct set forth in the order's findings of fact and to address any recommendations resulting from the assessment.

On April 13, 2017, the Board reviewed and accepted the report resulting from Respondent's fitness to practice evaluation. Based on the evaluator's recommendations, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's professional nursing license (#145249-30) is further LIMITED as follows:
  - a. Respondent shall continue mental health counseling and submit satisfactory quarterly reports from the treater to the Department Monitor.
  - b. Respondent shall present this Order to her nursing employer and submit verification of compliance and quarterly work reports to the Department Monitor.
  - c. Respondent may petition for full license after one (1) year of submission of satisfactory reports and compliance with the terms of the Dec. 8<sup>th</sup>, 2016 Order as determined by the Board.
