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

On November 14, 2013, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to comply with certain terms and conditions, including the completion of four (4) hours of education in "ethics of nursing" within 90 days and a fitness for duty assessment. The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has failed to comply with the requirements and as a result the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's professional nursing license (#98883-30) is hereby SUSPENDED.
2. The suspension shall remain in effect until Respondent has demonstrated successful completion of the education and assessment requirements of the Order.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
