

On November 14, 2013, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (“Board”) issued a Final Decision and Order (“Order”) suspending Respondent’s professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On February 9, 2017, the Board considered Respondent’s request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens, termination of direct supervision, and a reduction in AA/NA meetings. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent’s request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is GRANTED. Respondent’s frequency is hereby reduced to 36 urine screens per year and one annual hair test.
2. Respondent’s request for termination of direct supervision is hereby GRANTED.
3. Respondent’s request for a reduction in AA/NA meetings is hereby DENIED. Respondent must practice nursing under the conditions of the modified Order before the Board will consider amending other requirements.
4. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
5. This order is effective the date of its signing.
