On December 19, 2013, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's practical nursing license with certain terms and conditions, including participation in a drug monitoring program.

On April 13, 2017, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to not less than 28 urine screens per year and one annual hair test.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
