On April 10, 2014, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("April 10, 2014 Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license (#171720-30) with certain terms and conditions, including, but not limited to, participation in an approved drug monitoring program.

On May 11, 2017, the Board considered Respondent's request for full licensure or, in the event the Board does not grant full licensure, a reduction in drug screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to not less than 28 per year and one annual hair test.
2. Respondent's request for full licensure is hereby DENIED for failure to demonstrate continuous and successful compliance. Respondent must fully comply with the complete terms and conditions of the April 10, 2014 Order.
3. All other terms and conditions of the April 10, 2014 Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
