On April 15, 2014, the Wisconsin Cosmetology Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to pay \$194.00 in costs of the proceeding and a \$1,500.00 forfeiture. Respondent was ordered to submit an initial payment of \$194.00 within 90 days and \$250.00 per month thereafter. On February 2, 2015, Respondent's cosmetology practitioner and cosmetology manager license were suspended for failure to pay the costs of the proceeding and forfeiture as ordered.

Based upon the information of record, which includes proof that Respondent has now paid the costs of the proceeding and forfeiture in full, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. The suspension is terminated and Respondent's cosmetology practitioner license (#86866-82) and cosmetology manager license (#33142-81) are hereby returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credentials are removed.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
