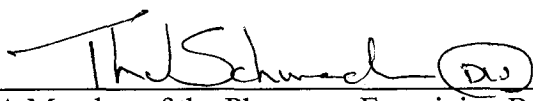
On April 10, 2014, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued an Order of Reinstatement of License with Suspension and Grant of Stay ("Order"), which reinstated Respondent's previously surrendered pharmacist license. Respondent's license was indefinitely suspended upon reinstatement; she has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On January 17, 2017, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to 28 per year and one annual hair test.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
