On February 12, 2015, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("February 12, 2015 Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On May 11, 2017, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens, a reduction in AA/NA meetings and access to controlled substances. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. The frequency is reduced to not less than twenty-eight (28) screens per year and one (1) hair test.
2. Respondent's request for a reduction in AA/NA meetings and access to controlled substances is hereby DENIED. Respondent needs to practice nursing under the conditions of the modified February 12, 2015 Order before the Board will consider amending other requirements.
3. All other terms and conditions of the February 12, 2015 Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
