On May 6, 2015, the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice dentistry in the state of Wisconsin for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On April 11, 2017, the Board Liaison considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens required. Based upon the information of record, the Board's designee finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to 36 drug and alcohol screens per year and one annual hair test.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
