On October 8, 2015, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On April 13, 2017, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens and a reduction in AA/NA meetings. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is hereby reduced to not less than 14 urine screens per year and one annual hair test while she is not working as a nurse. Upon employment as a nurse, the frequency shall increase to not less than 36 urine screens per year and one annual hair test.
2. Respondent's request for a reduction in AA/NA meetings is hereby DENIED due to insufficient time under the Order to demonstrate adequate compliance.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
