On December 22, 2015, the Wisconsin Chiropractic Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's license to practice chiropractic with certain terms and conditions, including, but not limited to, meeting with a professional mentor on a monthly basis.

On April 20, 2017, the Board designee considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of meetings with the professional mentor. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of meetings with the professional mentor is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to every other month.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
