On January 5, 2016, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued an Order Granting Limited License ("Order"), which granted Applicant a limited professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions.

On February 9, 2017, the Board considered Applicant's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens, termination of the AA/NA attendance verification log, and the ability to work in a home health, hospice, pool-nursing, or agency setting. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Applicant's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens, termination of the AA/NA attendance verification log, and the ability to work in a home health, hospice, pool-nursing, or agency setting is DENIED due to insufficient time under the Order to demonstrate adequate compliance.
