On March 10, 2016, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (“Board”) issued a Final Decision and Order (“Order”) limiting Respondent’s professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions, including participation in a drug monitoring program.

On December 29, 2017, the Board Monitoring Liaison considered Respondent’s request for a reduction in the frequency of drug screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board Monitoring Liaison finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent’s request for a reduction in drug screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent’s frequency is reduced to not less than 28 times per year and one annual hair test.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
