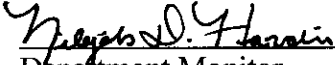

On April 19, 2016, the Wisconsin Social Worker Section of the Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling and Social Work Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to complete six (6) hours of education on the topic of "documentation" and six (6) hours on the topic of "assessment and treatment planning" within six months. The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has failed to comply with the education requirements and as a result the following is entered:

1. Respondent's independent social worker certificate (#839-122) is hereby SUSPENDED.
2. The suspension shall remain in effect until Respondent has demonstrated successful completion of the education requirements of the Order.
