On September 29, 2016, the Wisconsin Chiropractic Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's chiropractic license. Respondent was required to submit written notification to Medicare, Medicaid, all third-party payers, and to each patient who personally paid fees for chiropractic services during the period January 7, 2015 through September 24, 2015. Respondent was then required to submit a sworn affidavit to the Department pursuant to the terms of the Order.

Respondent has submitted proof that he successfully completed the requirements of the Order and as a result the following is entered:

1. Respondent's chiropractic license (#2365-12) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
