
On October 24, 2016, the Wisconsin Professional Counselor Section of the Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling, and Social Work Board ("Section") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional counselor licenses. Respondent was required to complete four hours of education on the topic of "ethics" and four hours in "boundaries" pursuant to the terms of the Order.

Respondent has submitted proof that he successfully completed the required education and as a result the following is entered:

1. Respondent's professional counselor licenses (#5752-125 and #1622-226) are returned to full, unrestricted status.
