On January 13, 2017, the Department of Safety and Professional Services issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter by which the Department ordered that pursuant to Wis. Stats. §440.22, the costs of this proceeding be assessed against the Respondent. The Department received the Affidavits of Costs from the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and the Division of Hearings and Appeals. The Department considered the Affidavits of Costs on February 10, 2017 and orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 440.22, the costs of this proceeding in the amount of \$1,728.98 are hereby assessed against the Respondent, and shall be payable by the Respondent to the Department of Safety and Professional Services. **Failure of the Respondent to make payment on or before January 15, 2018, shall constitute a violation of the Order unless the Respondent petitions for and the Board grants a different deadline.** Under Wis. Stats. § 440.22(3), the Department of Safety and Professional Services may not restore, renew or otherwise issue any credential to the Respondent until the Respondent has made payment to the Department in the full amount assessed.
