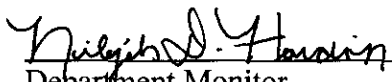
On March 1, 2017, the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's dentistry license. Respondent was required to complete eight (8) hours of education on the topic of treatment planning and eight (8) hours on risk management pursuant to the terms of the Order.

Respondent has submitted proof that he successfully completed the required education and as a result the following is entered:

1. Respondent's dentistry license (#2979-15) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credential are removed.
