The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Licensee Kyungsook Yoon, R.N., A.P.N.P., (dob November 13, 1969) is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a professional nurse, having license number 158260-30, first issued on April 23, 2007 and current through February 28, 2018. Licensee is also certified as an advanced practice nurse prescriber, having certificate number 6273-33, first issued on March 6, 2015 and current through September 30, 2018. Licensee's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is 4333 North Oakland Avenue, Apartment 308, Shorewood, Wisconsin 53211.

2. At all times relevant to this proceeding, Licensee was employed as a professional nurse at clinic, located in Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

3. On October 9, 2015, Patient A reported to Licensee that she had irritable bowel syndrome (IBS) with diarrhea.

4. Licensee documented in Patient A's medical record regarding her gastrointestinal history that Patient A denied nausea, vomiting, and constipation, but indicated diarrhea.

5. Licensee prescribed Linzess® 290 mcg 1 capsule by mouth daily 30 minutes before the first meal to treat Patient A's IBS.

6. Linzess® is used to treat IBS with constipation¹.

7. Patient A experienced a stomach ache after ingesting one (1) Linzess® capsule, but no other adverse or permanent effects.

8. Licensee stated that she prescribed the Linzess® for "occasions where constipation was the predominant symptom." Licensee further stated that Patient A had presented to the clinic with IBS with diarrhea with alternating constipation.

9. During a follow up conducted by a Department investigator, Licensee stated that she did not prescribe anything to treat Patient A's diarrhea because the Linzess® was used to regulate bowel in patients with IBS.

10. Licensee further stated that she did not observe that it was clearly documented in Patient A's medical record about her IBS with alternating constipation, but remembers the office visit and her assessment of Patient A.

11. Licensee failed to document that Patient A had indicated she experienced IBS with alternating constipation.

12. In resolution of this matter, Licensee consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

ORDER

1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.

2. Within six (6) months of the date of this Order, Kyungsook Yoon, R.N., A.P.N.P., shall at her own expense take and successfully complete five (5) hours of education on the topic

of documentation and one (1) of education on the topic of diagnosing and treating irritable bowel syndrome as follows:


- a. Each course attended in satisfaction of this Order must be pre-approved by the Board or its designee. Licensee shall be responsible for locating course(s) satisfactory to the Board and for obtaining the required approval of the courses from the Board or its designee. Licensee must take and pass any exam offered for the course(s).
- b. Licensee shall submit proof of successful completion of the education in the form of verification from the institution providing the education to the Department Monitor at the address stated below. None of the education completed pursuant to this requirement may be used to satisfy any education requirements that have been or may be instituted by the Board or Department.

3. Request for approval of courses and proof of successful course completion shall be sent by Licensee to the Department Monitor at the address below:

STIPULATION

Respondent Kyungsook Yoon, R.N., A.P.N.P., and the Division of Legal Services and Compliance, Department of Safety and Professional Services stipulate as follows:

1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of a pending investigation by the Division of Legal Services and Compliance. Respondent consents to the resolution of this investigation by Stipulation.

2. Respondent understands that by signing this Stipulation, Respondent voluntarily and knowingly waives the following rights:

- the right to a hearing on the allegations against Respondent, at which time the State has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence;
- the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against Respondent;
- the right to call witnesses on Respondent's behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena;
- the right to testify on Respondent's own behalf;
- the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision;
- the right to petition for rehearing; and
- all other applicable rights afforded to Respondent under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and other provisions of state or federal law.

3. Respondent is aware of Respondent's right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation.

4. Respondent agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (Board). The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondent waives all rights to any appeal of the Board's order, if adopted in the form as attached.

5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Board, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall then be returned to the Division

of Legal Services and Compliance for further proceedings. In the event that the Stipulation is not accepted by the Board, the parties agree not to contend that the Board has been prejudiced or biased in any manner by the consideration of this attempted resolution.

6. The parties to this Stipulation agree that the attorney or other agent for the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and any member of the Board ever assigned as an advisor in this investigation may appear before the Board in open or closed session, without the presence of Respondent, for purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that any member of the Board may have in connection with deliberations on the Stipulation. Additionally, any such advisor may vote on whether the Board should accept this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.

7. Respondent is informed that should the Board adopt this Stipulation, the Board's Final Decision and Order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Department procedure.

8. The Division of Legal Services and Compliance joins Respondent in recommending the Board adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
