1. Respondent Patrick O. Fiedler (DOB 03/17/1960) is registered by the State of Wisconsin as a Professional Engineer, having certificate of registration number 42012-6, first issued on November 23, 2011 and current through July 31, 2018. Respondent's most recent

address on file with the Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is 299 North Euclid Avenue, Suite 550, Pasadena, California 91101.

2. On September 27, 2012, the Ohio State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Surveyors disciplined Respondent for representing to the public that Fiedler Group was qualified to offer engineering services and providing engineering services at a time when Fiedler Group did not possess a certificate of authorization to do so. Respondent was fined \$500.

3. On November 15, 2015, the New York State Education Department, Office of Professional Discipline, State Board for Engineering and Land Surveying, disciplined Respondent for allowing Fiedler Group to offer and/or practice engineering in the State of Ohio without a certificate of authorization. Respondent was suspended for one year (suspension stayed), placed on probation for one year and fined \$1,500.

4. On December 8, 2015, Respondent notified the Department of his discipline from New York and Ohio.

5. On four occasions between March 25, 2013 and September 16, 2014, Respondent practiced professional engineering in Wisconsin as the engineer of record for Fiedler Group, which had no certificate of authorization.

6. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Professional Engineer Section of the Wisconsin Examining Board of Architects, Landscape Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Professional Land Surveyors has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 443.11, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent violated Wis. Admin. Code § A-E 8.08(4) by failing to notify the Department within 48 hours of being disciplined for unprofessional conduct in another state.

3. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent violated Wis. Admin. Code § A-E 8.09(1) by failing to comply with all state codes which relate to the practice of professional engineering.

4. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent violated Wis. Stat. § 443.08(2)(b)2. by practicing professional engineering as a principal, officer, employee, or agent of a firm, partnership or corporation without the firm, partnership, or corporation being issued a certificate of authorization.

5. As a result of the above violations, Patrick O. Fiedler is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 443.11(1)(e).

ORDER

1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.
2. Respondent Patrick O. Fiedler is REPRIMANDED.
3. Within 90 days from the date of this Order, Respondent shall pay COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$450.
4. Payment of costs shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services and sent to the Department Monitor at the address below:



5. In the event Respondent fail to timely submit payment of the costs as ordered, Respondent's certificate of registration (number 42012-6) may, in the discretion of the Section, be SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent complies with payment of the costs.

STIPULATION

Division of Legal Services and Compliance Case No. 15 ENG 067

Respondent Patrick O. Fiedler and the Division of Legal Services and Compliance, Department of Safety and Professional Services stipulate as follows:

1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of a pending investigation by the Division of Legal Services and Compliance. Respondent consents to the resolution of this investigation by Stipulation.

2. Respondent understands that by signing this Stipulation, Respondent voluntarily and knowingly waives the following rights:

- the right to a hearing on the allegations against Respondent, at which time the State has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence;
- the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against Respondent;
- the right to call witnesses on Respondent's behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena;
- the right to testify on Respondent's own behalf;
- the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision;
- the right to petition for rehearing; and
- all other applicable rights afforded to Respondent under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and other provisions of state or federal law.

3. Respondent is aware of Respondent's right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation. Respondent is represented by Attorney David E. Barker.


4. Respondent agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Professional Engineer Section of the Wisconsin Examining Board of Architects, Landscape Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Professional Land Surveyors (Section). The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondent waives all rights to any appeal of the Section's order, if adopted in the form as attached.

5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Section, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall then be returned to the Division of Legal Services and Compliance for further proceedings. In the event that the Stipulation is not accepted by the Section, the parties agree not to contend that the Section has been prejudiced or biased in any manner by the consideration of this attempted resolution.



The parties to this Stipulation agree that the attorney or other agent for the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and any member of the Section ever assigned as an advisor in this investigation may appear before the Section in open or closed session, without the presence of Respondent, for purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that any member of the Section may have in connection with deliberations on the Stipulation. Additionally, any such advisor may vote on whether the Section should accept this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.

7. Respondent is informed that should the Section adopt this Stipulation, the Section's Final Decision and Order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Department procedure.


8. The Division of Legal Services and Compliance joins Respondent in recommending the Section adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
