On May 3, 2017, the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's dentistry license for an indefinite period. Respondent may petition for a stay of suspension upon providing proof that he has been compliant with Sections C and D of the Order for the most recent thirty (30) consecutive days.

Respondent's petition for an initial stay of suspension has been reviewed pursuant to the Order. Based upon the information of record, which demonstrates that Respondent qualifies for a stay of suspension at this time, the following is entered:
