
On May 11, 2017, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing issued a Final Decision and Order (“Order”) requiring Respondent to complete four (4) hours of education in “nurse practice acts” within 90 days. The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has failed to comply with the education requirements and as a result the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent’s practical nursing license (#312160-31) is hereby SUSPENDED.
2. The suspension shall remain in effect until Respondent has demonstrated successful completion of the education requirements of the Order.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.


