
**ADDENDUM TO CITATION FOR ADMINISTRATIVE FORFEITURE -
PAYMENT PLAN**

Dear Mr. White:

You have received one or more citations for violations of the Safety and Professional Services rules and have requested the opportunity to enter into a payment agreement to resolve those citations. By returning an original signed copy of this letter along with partial payment, you accept the forfeitures imposed on the citations you received and agree to pay the forfeiture amounts in full. To enter into this agreement and to accept the payment plan below:

- You must sign and date this document below and return the original to Investigator Brian Henry at the address listed above (use the enclosed return envelope).
- You must also include a partial payment of 50% of the total amount due on the citation(s) when returning this document. 50% of \$1000 is \$500.
- **You must return at least the white copy of the signed and dated citation(s) with this document.**
- Subsequent payment of \$500 is due on or before July 15, 2017. **The payment must be sent to the Department Monitor at the address above. In order to assure each payment is credited properly, all payments must reference the case number, 16 RBR 002, somewhere on the check.**
- You agree that if you fail to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, your license may, in the discretion of the board or its designee, be **SUSPENDED**, without further notice or hearing, until you have complied with payment of the forfeiture(s).
