On July 13, 2017, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license. Respondent was required to complete five (5) hours of education on the topic of documentation and four (4) hours of education on medication administration, pursuant to the terms of the Order. Respondent was also required to provide her nursing employer with a copy of her Order and to provide the Department Monitor with written acknowledgment from each nursing employer that a copy of the Order was received.

Respondent has submitted proof that she successfully completed the required education and provided her nursing employer with a copy of the Order. As a result, the following is entered:

1. Respondent's professional nursing license (#169325-30) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
