On July 13, 2017, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions including, but not limited to, completion of an AODA assessment by an evaluator pre-approved by the Board or its designee who has experience conducting these assessments.

On November 9, 2017, the Board reviewed the report resulting from Respondent's AODA assessment. Based upon the information of record and the terms of the Order, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. The results of the assessment and evaluator's recommendations do not provide a basis to impose additional limitations. Therefore, Respondent's professional nursing license (#154308-30) is hereby returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credential are hereby removed.
