On September 14, 2017, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's practical nursing license. Respondent was required to complete five (5) hours of education on the topic of documentation and four (4) hours of education on the topic of medication errors, pursuant to the terms of the Order.
