The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Licensee Mary A. Verzich, R.N., (DOB January 10, 1957) is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a professional nurse, having license number 219541-30, first issued on September 29, 2014 and current through February 28, 2018. Licensee's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is 1417 North 8th Avenue E, Duluth, Minnesota 55805.
- 2. At all times relevant to this proceeding, Licensee was employed as a professional nurse at a nursing facility (Facility), located in Superior, Wisconsin.

- 3. On August 13, 2016, during dinner, Patient A stood several times from his wheelchair and almost fell on the other residents seated at his table. Patient A was extremely unsteady on his feet and would lean on other residents when he stood.
- 4. During the medication pass in the dining room, Patient A continued to be restless. Licensee attempted to keep Patient A with her to help distract him and keep him safe.
- 5. Licensee placed a gait belt loosely around Patient A's waist, with the buckle in the front, got Patient A's food tray and sat with him while he ate.
- 6. During the Facility investigation, Licensee admitted to applying the gait belt to Patient A but stated the restraint was for his and others safety.
 - 7. Licensee was terminated from her employment with the Facility.
- 8. In resolution of this matter, Licensee consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

ORDER

- 1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.
- 2. Within six (6) months of the date of this Order, Mary A. Verzich, R.N., shall at her own expense take and successfully complete three (3) hours of education on the topic of patient's rights, three (3) hours of education on the topic of restraints and four (4) hours of education on the topic of ethics in nursing as follows:
 - a. Each course attended in satisfaction of this Order must be pre-approved by the Board or its designee. Licensee shall be responsible for locating course(s) satisfactory to the Board and for obtaining the required approval of the courses from the Board or its designee. Licensee must take and pass any exam offered for the course(s).
 - b. Licensee shall submit proof of successful completion of the education in the form of verification from the institution providing the education to the Department Monitor at the address stated below. None of the education completed pursuant to this requirement may be used to satisfy any education requirements that have been or may be instituted by the Board or Department.
- 3. Request for approval of courses and proof of successful course completion shall be sent by Licensee to the Department Monitor at the address below:

- 1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of a pending investigation by the Division of Legal Services and Compliance. Licensee consents to the resolution of this investigation by Stipulation.
- 2. Licensee understands that by signing this Stipulation, Licensee voluntarily and knowingly waives the following rights:
 - the right to a hearing on the allegations against Licensee, at which time the State has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence;
 - the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against Licensee;
 - the right to call witnesses on Licensee's behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena;
 - the right to testify on Licensee's own behalf;
 - the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision;
 - the right to petition for rehearing; and
 - all other applicable rights afforded to Licensee under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and other provisions of state or federal law.
- 3. Licensee is aware of Licensee's right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation.
- 4. Licensee agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (Board). The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Licensee waives all rights to any appeal of the Board's order, if adopted in the form as attached.
- 5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Board, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall then be returned to the Division of Legal Services and Compliance for further proceedings. In
