

You are hereby notified that you are subject to an administrative forfeiture of \$1,000.00 in accordance with Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.125(1)(b)1. This forfeiture must be paid within 30 days of the date of mailing of this Notice, or a 12% interest penalty will be assessed.

You have the right to request a review of the assessment of forfeiture by sending a request to the Division Administrator, Division of Industry Services, P.O. Box 7302, Madison, Wis. 53707-7302, which must be received by the Division no later than 30 days from the date of mailing of this Notice. Any review of the assessment of forfeiture will be held in accordance with the requirements set forth in Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.125(6-8).

You are receiving this administrative forfeiture because you installed plumbing without a license at 1222 West Hiawatha Drive, Appleton, Wisconsin 54914. Your actions violated Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.90(1)(a). The administrative forfeiture of \$1,000.00 is assessed in accordance with Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.125(1)(b)1.

You are hereby notified that your Dwelling Contractor Qualifier credential is suspended for two months, beginning January 22, 2018.

The basis for this suspension is the addition you constructed at 1222 West Hiawatha Drive, Appleton, Wisconsin 54914. You pulled a permit for this addition, application number 12603. On this permit you listed Bob's Quality Heating, Michael's Power, and Turek's Plumbing as subcontractors. These three contractors have all denied being part of the original project in notarized statements. This conduct constitutes misconduct under Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.10(1)(a)5. This violation is a basis for discipline pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code ch. SPS 305.


You installed both plumbing and HVAC at this site, without possessing a valid master plumber license or HVAC contractor credential. You admitted to performing plumbing and the Department of Safety and Professional Services possesses documents stating you installed HVAC. You also failed to contact the local inspector to perform the necessary inspections at this site and were cited by the local inspector, Jeff Kopecky. This conduct constitutes a violation of a state law relating to the conduct of the activities under the license under Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.10(1)(a)8. This violation is a basis for discipline pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code ch. SPS 305.

You installed the incorrect door between the addition and existing attached garage. A 20-minute fire rated door is required between a dwelling and an attached garage. Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 321.08(1)(c). Inspector Kopecky inspected the door and found that it was not fire rated. This conduct constitutes incompetence under Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.10(1)(a)3. This violation is a basis for discipline pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code ch. SPS 305.

After the two month suspension, you may request, in writing, to have your credential reinstated. The reinstatement process is set forth in Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.10(1)(f).

You have the right to request a hearing on the suspension by sending a request for hearing to the Department of Safety and Professional Services, Chief Legal Counsel, P.O. Box 8368, Madison, Wisconsin 53708-8368, which must be received by the Department no later than 30 days from the date of mailing of this Notice. Any hearing on the suspension will be held in accordance with the requirements set forth in Wis. Stat. ch. 227.
