On March 15, 1995, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") granted Applicant a limited drug manufacturer license and a limited wholesale distributor of prescription drugs license in the state of Wisconsin. Pursuant to the Final Decision and Order Granting Limited Licenses ("Order") issued in the same date, Applicant's licenses were limited with certain terms and conditions. Respondent's wholesale distributor's license has been inactive since 2008.

Applicant has submitted a request for removal of the limitations and the return of their licenses to full, unrestricted status. Based upon the information of record, the Board's designee finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Applicant's request for the return of their drug manufacturer license (#269-44) to full, unrestricted status is hereby GRANTED.
2. The limitations imposed on Applicant's wholesale distributor's license pursuant this Order are deemed satisfied, however this license (#722-45) remains inactive.
