On March 1, 2007, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On November 8, 2018, the Board considered Respondent's request for the ability to work in home health and public health, termination of direct supervision and a reduction of AA/NA meetings to once per week. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for the ability to work in home health and public health, termination of direct supervision and a reduction of AA/NA meetings to once per week is DENIED for failure to demonstrate continuous and successful compliance under the terms of the Order (3/1/2007).
