On August 15, 2007, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's physician assistant license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On June 11, 2018, the Board designee considered Respondent's request to terminate the drug and alcohol treatment required pursuant to the Order. Based upon the information of record, including a recommendation from Respondent's Treater, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for termination of the drug and alcohol treatment requirement is GRANTED.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
