On August 15, 2007, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's physician assistant license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On October 17, 2018, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the required number of drug and alcohol screens and termination of AA/NA meetings. Based upon the information of record, the Board makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in required number of drug and alcohol screens and termination of AA/NA meetings is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's required number of drug and alcohol screens is reduced to not less than 14 screens per year and one annual hair test.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
