On December 3, 2009, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On April 12, 2018, the Board considered Respondent's request for the return of full licensure. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for the return of her professional nursing license (#140671-30) to full, unrestricted status is hereby DENIED. Instead, the Board grants a reduction in screens to not less than 20 urine tests and 1 hair test per year. Respondent needs to practice nursing under the conditions of the modified Board Order before the Board will consider amending other requirements.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
